



# SUMMER CAMPS 2009

## **POLICIES AND PROCEDURES**



### **General information**

The Mebane Acting Company, Inc., 2009 MUSICAL THEATRE CAMP teaches the basic aspects (voice and dance) in the preparation of a musical theatre production and also a basic history and appreciation of the musicals studied. The 2009 ACTING CAMP teaches basic theatre techniques, including vocal interpretation, pantomime, body movement, beginning improvisation, as also audition preparedness.

### **Fees**

The fee for one camp is \$75.00 per attendee. If attending both the Musical Theatre Camp and Acting Camp, the fee is \$135.00 per attendee. This fee is non-refundable, applies to all participants in the camp, and cannot be reduced based on your child's attendance. This fee pays for facility usage, counselor compensation, and snacks.

### **Schedule**

The camp runs Monday, July 27, 2009, through Friday, July 31, 2009. The Musical Theatre Camp runs from 8:30 -11:30 AM. Acting Camp runs from 12:00 - 3:00 PM. Please arrive promptly for drop-off and pick-up. A free public performance will be held on Friday, July 31st.

### **Snacks and Lunch**

Snacks and drinks will be provided each day. Please feel free to send your child with bottled water. Children will NOT be permitted to use the vending machines. Students attending both camps MUST bring a bag lunch from home to be eaten from 11:30 AM - Noon.

### **Clothing**

Your child should be dressed comfortably with appropriate gym shoes. If your child's shoes are not suitable, we will request that he/she participate in bare feet. NO FLIP-FLOPS.

### **Discipline**

The camps are intended to be informative and fun. All participants are expected to cooperate with the counselors and be considerate of others. If any behavior is deemed inappropriate, the child will be separated from the group (i.e. time-out). Any behavior issues will be discussed with parents. The Mebane Acting Company, Inc., reserves the right to dismiss your child for severe behavior problems.

### **Illness**

Children arriving at camp must be in good health and free from symptoms or things that would be contagious. Please be considerate of the other participants and the counselors. If your child becomes ill while at the camp, he/she will be separated from the other children. You will be notified immediately to pick up your child.

### **Checking In**

For your child's safety, you will be required to sign your child in each day. On the first day of camp, please escort your child into the center and complete all necessary paperwork before leaving. After the first day, one of our counselors will be waiting outside under the roof of the community center with the sign-in sheet and to receive your child. Please drive-thru to drop off your child. Please let the Director know at this time if someone other than you will be picking up your child.

### **Checking Out**

For your child's safety, you will be required to sign your child out at the close of camp each day. One of our counselors will be waiting outside under the roof of the community center with the sign-out sheet and your child. Please drive-thru to pick up your child. Please let the Director know in advance if someone other than you will be picking up your child. Your child will not be released to someone else unless written notice is made in advance. **IF YOU ARE MORE THAN 5 MINUTES LATE IN PICKING UP YOUR CHILD, YOU WILL BE CHARGED A FEE OF \$1 PER MINUTE FOR EACH MINUTE YOU ARE LATE. PLEASE BE CONSIDERATE OF OUR COUNSELORS AND BE ON TIME.**

Children attending both camps will receive a free tee-shirt. Those attending one camp, parents, and siblings may purchase a shirt for \$12 each. Please specify on the registration form if you will be ordering shirt(s).
